Dear all,

Well, it is that time of year again. Life is going to fast for me. Just seems like we finished this project the other day. I am again writing and asking for you help with this special missions project called the "Easter Angel Project."

The "Easter Angel Project" is a missions project sponsored through the Central Virginia Baptist Association and the Charlottesville/Albemarle Joint Security Complex. Each year we take forms over to the jail and the Chaplin there hands each inmate that will be incarcerated at the time of Easter a form to fill out with their child's name and address and guardian's name on them. We collect approximately 300 names each year. Last year we fixed 325 Easter Baskets with your help.

We are in need for all the churches to come together as a group and to take at least 10-15 names and fill baskets for each child and deliver them to their homes the week before Easter. This is a great witness when you take the baskets to their homes and see the expression on that family members face that someone cared enough for their children to fix an Easter basket. It is a very rewarding project not only for them, but also for us as Christians.
